Sealed Bids for GRSD Sewer Authority's Lift Station #6 Replacement, will be received by the Authority, at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 10831 Kruger Road, New Buffalo, Michigan 49117, (269) 469-3434, until 3:00 pm, local time, on Monday July 26, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

Contract #6 Description: (Base Bid)

In general, the work consists of replacing the existing lift station #6 with a new station, which will be located approximately 30 feet northeasterly from the existing location north of Brown Road along Red Arrow Highway, Chikaming Township, Berrien County, MI. New lift station will include two new pumps, new piping, a new prefabricated electrical building to contain motor controls and telemetry equipment, and a new diesel generator. Movement of the existing Lift Station #6 diesel generator to the wastewater plant. Temporary and permanent piping will be installed to allow for continued use of the existing lift station during construction of the new station.

Contract #7 Description: (Bid Alternate 1)

In general, the work consists of replacing the existing lift station #8 with a new station, which will be located directly east of the existing station. New lift station will include construction using the sinking caisson method. New lift station will also include two new pumps, new piping, motor control panel, and installation of the diesel generator being moved from Lift Station #6. Movement of the generator from Lift Station #6 to the GRSD Sewer Authority wastewater treatment plant is under a separate contract. Movement of the generator from the wastewater treatment plant to Lift Station #8 will be part of this contract. Temporary bypass and permanent piping will be installed to allow for continued use of the existing lift station during construction of the new station.

Contract Award:

The selected contractor must bid on Contract 6. The selected contractor is also made aware that the GRSD is seeking pricing for the construction of Contract 6 and Contract 7, to determine if funds are available to construct both projects at this time. The selected contractor is made aware that it is the sole discretion of the GRSD to award contract 6 alone, or both Contract 6 and Contract 7.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
