Sealed Bids for East Cornelia Street Sewer Separation, Division A – Sanitary and Storm Sewers, will be received by the Village of Hicksville, at the Village Hall at 111 South Main Street, Hicksville, Ohio 43526, until 2:00 p.m., local time, on May 23, 2017, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consists of the installation of 1,000 lineal feet of 15 and 12-inch storm sewer, and replacement of 125 lineal feet of sanitary sewer and pavement restorations.

The Engineers Estimate is \$195,386.00.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates established by the Federal Davis-Bacon Wage Rate Determination Issued by the U.S. Department of Interior.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small business in rural areas (SBRAs).

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
