#### WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT DIGESTER IMPROVEMENTS

#### CONTRACT 2

Sealed Bids for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Digester Improvements, Contract No. 2 will be received by the Michigan City Sanitary District at its administrative office at 1100 E. Eighth Street, Michigan City, IN. 46360-2567 until 4:00 pm, local time on June 28, 2017—and, thereafter, at the meeting there of the District's Board of Commissioners, which is scheduled to begin at 4:00 pm, local time, until the presiding officer calls the agenda item for opening the bids at which time the time for submitting bids will be declared closed. Any bids received after that time will not be considered. All bids timely received will be publicly opened and read aloud. The Board will announce the award of the Bid within 45 days of said opening.

In general, the work consists of the construction of a below grade concrete vault, improvements to digester gas piping and electrical components. A MANDATORY Pre-Bid meeting will be held at the District's administrative office on June 21, 2017 at 11:00 am, attendance is mandatory. A representative of the Michigan City Human Rights Department will be in attendance to present Michigan City Ordinance #4317 and to answer questions regarding local hiring requirements. An opportunity to visit the Digester Improvements area of the WWTP site will be available after the meeting.

Bids must be submitted on the forms bound herein, must contain the names of every person or company interested therein, and shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond in the amount of 10% of the amount bid with satisfactory corporate surety or by a certified check on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to Form 96 conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance and Payment Bonds in the amount of 100% of the contract price.

The successful Contractor will be required to enroll in and verify the work eligibility status of all employees hired after the date of this Contract through the E-Verify program. The Contractor will also be required to sign an affidavit denying Contractor knowingly employing unauthorized aliens. A copy of the affidavit is included in the Bid Documents.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bid.
