Sealed Bids for 100 Area Lead Service Elimination/Replacement, will be received by the Northwestern Water & Sewer District, at the Operations Facility, 12560 Middleton Pike, Bowling Green, Ohio 43402, until 11:00 a.m., local time, on January 4, 2018, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consists of the replacement of 145 lead water services with an alternate bid requested for the replacement of 177 lead water services.

Bids must be submitted on the forms bound herein, must contain the names of every person or company interested therein, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in the amount of 100% of the amount bid with satisfactory corporate surety, or by a certified check on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10 percent of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates established by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
