Sealed Bids for Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements, Contract 4, will be received by the Village of Oak Hill, at the Village Offices, 415 N. Front Street, Oak Hill, Ohio 45656, until 6:30 p.m. local time, during the regular Board of Affairs meeting on October 24, 2017, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consists of a new screen and grit channel improvements; aeration tanks diffuser replacement; new final clarifier; new UV system; lab/office building and a new vacuum tank. The Engineer's estimate for total construction is \$1,400,000.00.

Bids must be submitted on the forms bound herein, must contain the names of every person or company interested therein, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in the amount of 100% of the amount bid with satisfactory corporate surety, or by a certified check on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

Attention of bidders is call to all requirements contained in this bid packet. General requirements are contained in the Additional Supplementary Conditions and include Equal Opportunity Requirements, Minority and Woman's Business Enterprise Utilization, Debarment, the Violating Facilities Clause, and the use of Small Business in Rural Areas. Davis-Bacon (Federal) Prevailing Wage Determinations must be used.

Attention of bidders is called to the Buy American Requirements pertaining to iron and steel products.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small business in rural areas (SBRAs).

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

The successful bidder will be required to complete the "Declaration Regarding Material Assistance/Non-Assistance to a Terrorist Organization" (DMA) in accordance with ORC Section 2909.32 and 2909.33.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
