Sealed Bids for WWTP Improvements, will be received by the City of Otsego, Michigan, at the City Hall, 117 East Orleans; Otsego, Michigan 49078, until 3:00 p.m., local time, on July 12, 2017, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consists of improvements to the following: Construction of new raw sewage pumping station and abandonment of the of the existing, replacement of chemical (ferric chloride) dosing system and yard piping, replacement of digester recirculation pump, removal and replacement of sludge heating boiler and heat exchanger, installation of a new digester mixing system, and demolition of the above-ground portions of the North Street Pump Station and replacement with a new concrete slab.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the WWTP, 210 N. Grant Street, Otsego, Michigan 49078 at 10:00 a.m. on June 27, 2017. Attendance at this meeting is mandatory for all contractors.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid, and Labor and Material Bond in the amount of 50% of the Bid.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
