Sealed Bids for The Final Clarifier Improvements Project, Contract 7, will be received by the Paw Paw Lake Area Joint Sewage Disposal Board Wastewater Treatment Plant at 4689 Defield Road, Coloma MI 49038, (269) 468-7888, during the normal business hours of 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM, until 1:00pm, local time, on January 11, 2018, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

*In general, the work consists of rehabilitation and improvements to the east and west final clarifiers at the PPLA WWTP. Work includes demolition/removal and replacements of the clarifier mechanisms, weirs, baffles, and appurtenances of both final clarifiers at the PPLA WWTP. Improvements also include repair of cracked and spalled concrete and coating of the clarifier interior concrete surfaces.*

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid, and Labor and Material Bond in the amount of 50% of the Bid.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 30 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
