Sealed Bids for *Kalamazoo Street Pump Station Improvements* will be received by the *City of South Haven*, at the Public Works Department, 1199 8th Avenue, South Haven, MI 49090, until 3:00 pm, local time, on Wednesday August 11, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consists of **Mechanical, Electrical, Structural improvements and related Site work to the existing Kalamazoo Street sanitary sewer pump station. Upgrades include installation of owner supplied pumps, motors, and variable frequency drives. New heating and ventilating equipment, sanitary force main and magnetic flowmeter, sanitary manhole, process piping, valves, and related electrical equipment. Building improvements include brick repair, painting, lighting, doors, and roofing.**

Bid Alternate 1 includes a complete standby power system including a natural gas fired generator and related equipment.

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 30 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
